

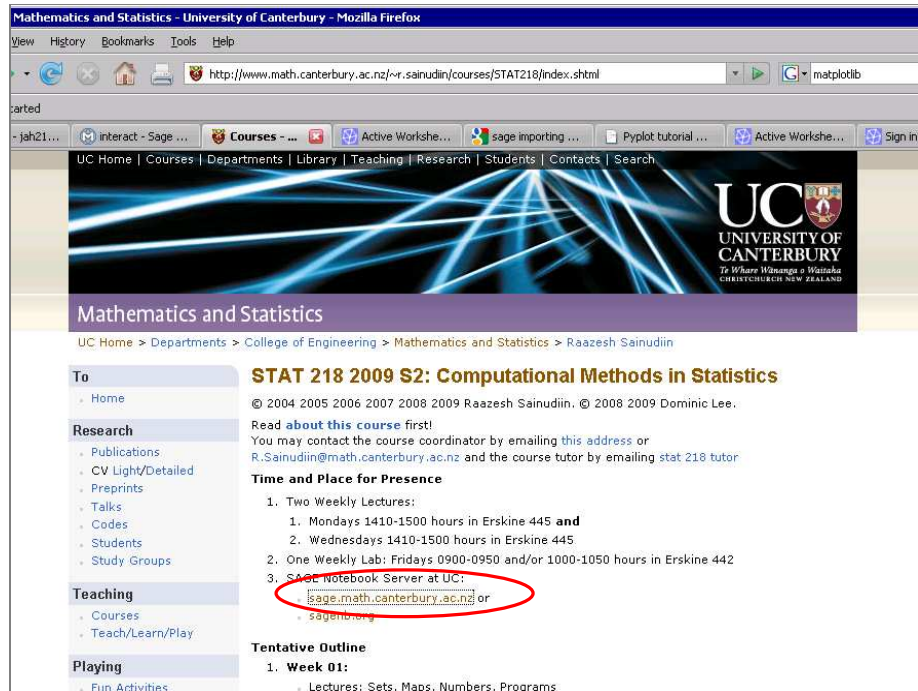

Creating an account on the Math Department Sage Notebook server

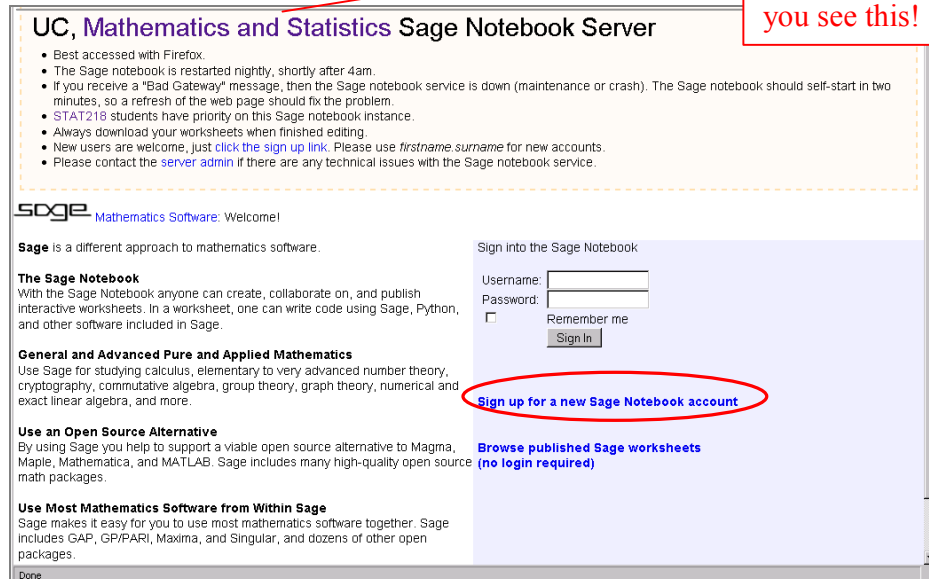

Note: you should only have to sign up for new account once, at the start of the course: After that you will be able to just log on to your existing account.

1. Use Mozilla Firefox as your browser.
2. Get to the Math Dept. Sage Notebook server from the course page or directly from the URL above.
3. Make sure you use the link to the Canterbury server (not sagenb).



4. You should get a page that looks like this.
5. Check the heading matches so that you know that you are on the Canterbury (UC) server.
6. Then click [Sign up for a new Sage Notebook account](#).



Check that you see this!

7. The Sage Notebook account sign-up page looks like this.
8. Make yourself a username. We'd like you to use **firstname.surname** if possible (for example, angus.mcgurkinshaw). It will be easier for you if you put everything in lower case, ie don't capitalise your firstname or surname.

Sign up for a Sage Notebook account

- 1 **Create a username**
Your username must start with a letter and be between 4 and 32 characters long. You may only use letters, numbers, underscores, and one dot (.).

UC, Mathematics and Statistics note:

- Please use *firstname.surname* as your username if possible

- 2 **Create a good password**
Your password must be between 6 and 32 characters long. Your password can not contain your username nor spaces.

- 3 **Re-type your password**

9. Then create a password. You can use a new password or your usual university one.
10. Retype the password in the second box.

- 1 **Create a username**
